The first industry was 'NSL sugar' factory in Koppa. The students witnessed the process of sugar making in three different mills or rollers. Where the juice is extracted from sugar cane, heated with sulphur dioxide, further heated for filtering and returned for further processing. The clear juice is then sent for sugar grains formation. Crystals are developed into desired size.

The second visit was an organic farm called as 'Organic Mandya'. Here the students enjoyed the lunch prepared with organic products. Later visited the organic stores where many students and faculty members purchased organic products. Lastly, the team visited the much-awaited place the farm where the organic vegetables were grown. The manager of the farm very effectively educated the students of the importance of organic products and its benefits.

On the way back, Lord Aprameya and Baby Krishna temple in Mallur and the Maralvadi dam near Ramnagar were visited where tea and snack were served.
