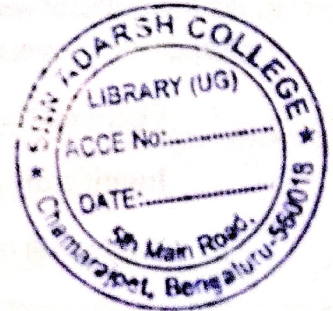

- Swapna: Of course! Using a washing machine is easy once you get the hang of it. Let's go step by step.
- Suma: Great! What's the first thing to do?
- Swapna: First, separate your clothes by colour-lights, darks, and delicate. Check the labels on your clothes for any special washing instructions.
- Suma: Okay, done. What next?
- Swapna: Now, open the machine and load your clothes. Don't overfill it; leave some space for the clothes to move around.
- Suma: Got it. And the detergent?
- Swapna: Add detergent in the dispenser or directly into the drum, depending on your machine. If needed, add fabric softener in the designated slot. Use the right amount to avoid excess foam.
- Suma: Alright. How do I select the settings?
